 **1885 Benz**  
**Patent Motorwagen**

One of the most significant automobiles in transportation history, the 1885 Benz Patent Motorwagen was the first commercially available automobile ever offered. Karl Benz, the visionary inventor, used his work of 10 years as inspiration for his design. He received his first patent in 1886 as an automobile fueled by gas.

Even today it is strikingly similar to the original. Offering a rear-mounted, single-cylinder four-stroke 95-horsepower engine, the Motorwagen can achieve 25 miles per gallon and have a top speed of 16 mph. It boasts solid rubber tires, large steel-sprung wheels, and a single-speed transmission. Although its primary engine lay behind the front axle, it was revolutionary at the time and the father of automobile invention.
